**AFFIDAVIT OF QUETHLIE ALEXIS**

I, QUETHLIE ALEXIS Make Oath and Say as follows:

1. I was born on the 14<sup>th</sup> February 1970 and am a married woman with one child. All the facts which I depose to below are within my own personal knowledge and are true.
2. I have consulted Messrs Callenders & Co and sworn this affidavit because of my concern for the baby girl, Danielynne, the daughter of Ms Marshall, born on the 7<sup>th</sup> September 2006 and also because of concern for my own position.
3. I was employed by Ms Marshall starting on the 4<sup>th</sup> September 2006 as the proposed nursery maid and nanny for Ms Marshall's expected baby daughter, (to be called Danielynne) who was in fact born just 3 days later.
4. My employment was at the residence of Ms Marshall in the Bahamas, a substantial house and grounds in the Eastern District of Nassau, called Horizons.

5. My employment was from 8am in the morning until 10pm at night, 7 days a week. My husband would deliver me in the morning to Horizons and pick me up at night.
6. There are 3 topics upon which I wish to make a formal sworn record in this affidavit. The first concerns the treatment of the baby. The second concerns the suitability of Ms Marshall as a mother of the baby. The third topic concerns the flagrant sexual relationship between Ms Marshall and The Hon. Shane Gibson, the Bahamian Minister of Immigration. I must state here that I myself have been seeking a renewal of my work permit for the Bahamas since February 2006, without any progress, let alone success, whereas Ms Marshall has succeeded in her immigration processing almost immediately because of, in my opinion, her personal relationship with the Minister. Certainly the hours and hours she spent alone in her bedroom with him, was time which she should have spent caring for and feeding her baby.

**Treatment of her baby girl, Danielynne Lynn**

7. Ms Marshall was obsessed with making sure that her baby was "sexy". She repeatedly told me that she wanted her baby to be "sexy". The practical consequence of this obsession was that I was absolutely instructed to underfeed the baby. Ms Marshall knew perfectly well, as did I, that the correct amount of baby food for Danielynne was 3oz every 3 hours. The doctor confirmed this when he examined Danielynne on Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup> October. But Ms Marshall insisted that the maximum feed I was to give was 2.5ozs. She enforced this regime by making sure that the baby monitor was kept on all the time so that she could hear when I started a feed and could question me about it and she also insisted that I warmed the baby's milk in the microwave and not the baby warmer, so that she could hear the microwave and check up on the amount of feed for the baby. The result of this is that Danielynne is badly underweight and not thriving, as a baby should. Because

of the many hours spent by me with Danielynne and the absence of Ms Marshall in any bonding process with Danielynne, the baby and I grew very close. Ms Marshall accused me of wishing Danielynne to believe that I was her mother (which is untrue) and Ms Marshall said to me that if ever Danielynne were to call me "mummy", "I will have to shoot you". I am afraid that given Ms Marshall's state of mind and general behaviour, that I believed her. From time to time, I was assisted in my duties as nursery maid and nanny for Danielynne, by The Hon. Shane Gibson's mother and also by a friend of the Ministers whose first name was Shirley, which is all I learnt. I found these rather random assistants, whose only connection was their relationship with the Minister, rather unsettling for the baby. One of the most important aspects of a baby's early months must be the regularity and predictability of care. On one occasion when Ms Marshall went into hospital, I was amazed when the woman "Shirley" came and took Danielynne from me for a hospital visit. For practical purposes, she was a complete stranger to Danielynne.

Ms Marshall

8. On two (2) occasions during my employment at Horizons, Ms Marshall attempted to commit suicide. On the first occasion she drank in my presence an entire bottle of what I believed to be a liquid sleeping aid. In any event the consequence was that Ms Marshall was in an unrousable coma for 48 hours. When she in fact recovered, she was very sick and ill with diarrhea and I asked her why she had drunk the liquid. She replied "I wanted to die...I meant to kill myself". I felt this to be very irresponsible as a mother of a baby. Very shortly after this, Ms Marshall was taken by Mr. Howard Stern and "Mo" (her security guard) and placed her in a patio chair by the pool; it went very quiet after awhile and I asked where she was and Ms. Marshall was found in the swimming pool. She had tried to drown herself. But she was, after a worrying length of time, pulled up from the bottom of the pool by a

Mr. Howard Stern, who said to Ms Marshall, in my presence, the rather odd remark that "...if anything happens to you, I would go to jail...".

9. The whole domestic regime for Danielynne is wild and unpredictable and her feeding is improper. In addition, Ms Marshall takes daily a lot of mood altering substances, with the result that she spends a lot of time asleep or resting in bed and when she is up and about, her mood swings are extreme, and are very unsettling and I am therefore concerned for the baby's welfare.

#### The Hon Shane Gibson

10. I am fully familiar with the Hon Shane Gibson (the "minister"). From the outset of my employment I observed that Ms Marshall had a close relationship with the minister. During September, October and November 2006, the minister came to Horizons, with perhaps the odd exception, on a daily basis. He drove himself alone, either in a dark truck or in his jeep (a blue Ford Explorer) and he would park inconspicuously in a back road nearby and enter Horizons through the service entrance. On a daily basis he would spend hours alone with Ms Marshall in her bedroom. His visits were in the evening (before I left) and occasionally during the early afternoon. I was never myself present in the bedroom observing them having sexual intercourse, but I am myself a married woman and I observed the minister with Ms Marshall on a very large number of occasions and in particular before they went into the bedroom and after they came out and it was absolutely plain to me that their relationship was sexual. The whole situation with the minister was bizarre. He did not seem to mind the presence of other persons in Horizons when he was in the bedroom with Ms Marshall. My judgment was that he was completely infatuated with her and entirely careless of anything else but his daily visits to her bedroom.

#### My dismissal

11. Notwithstanding the generally disreputable and unsuitable household in which I worked, my only concern was to do my absolute best to look after Danielyne. For that reason I stayed and would still be at Horizons now, but for the final example of Ms Marshall's mood swings, sometimes into temper. On Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2006, there was delivered to Horizons a new washing machine. This was a front loading washing machine with which I was not familiar. I was accused of misplacing the user manual. Ms Marshall was livid with me for not being able to locate the washing machine manual and dismissed me on the spot for that "failure".
